Homework Policy

The School community of Two Mile House believe in the value of homework and it is assigned with the following aims in mind:-

- 1. To reinforce new concepts, skills and vocabulary.
- 2. To reinforce procedures and drills,
- 3. To help to identify areas of difficulty.
- 4. To promote good study habits and skills.
- 5. To act as a home-school link and to promote parental involvement.

Homework Guidelines

- (a) The child's genuine effort is asked for. Homework completed with significant help from adults is greatly devalued.
- (b) Parents should, where possible, listen to children reading and check oral learning.
- (c) Homework should be a point of contact, not conflict between parent and child.
- (d) If a child is unable to complete assigned homework within the recommended time then the work should be left undone and the child's teacher should be informed.
- (e) Homework notebooks should be signed every evening by parents and a record of the amount of time homework has taken should be written in notebook.
- (f) It is school policy that homework is not assigned at weekends unless a child needs to make up for uncompleted homework during the week.
- (g) The school regards oral or mental homework as being just as important as written assignments.

Junior Classes: Infants, Junior and Senior – informal work assigned by teacher

and indicated to parents individually.

First and Second: 20 - 30 minutes Third and Fourth: 30 - 40 minutes Fifth and Sixth: 40 minutes - 1 hour
